To me it means to attune to all of this: to live in a better accordance with objects and beings.


To stop caring about complying to the shape of bodies shown to us in the constant spectacle.

and on our own very selves.









Although far-fetched, nature and man-made objects undeniably rely on each other in a circle of waste, construction, realization, destruction, and rejuvenation. Without nature, humanity won't have the building blocks which led us to today. The idea was perceived long before our time, heavily rooted in the survival of beastly creatures, amongst other living things, using their surroundings as shelter to protect themselves from harm. Unkept relics of the past have mostly been succumbed by the force of nature, resulting in a repeated circle that laid the groundwork for today's modern civilization.




The objective is to traverse the circle using three-dimensional forms, distorting it into a paradoxical form representing the bond between nature and man.

Using architectural and engineering programs, the cluster of forms representing man vs. nature reveals the modus operandi

of growth. From its predetermined fundamental genesis, the geometric shapes divulge the method of algorithmic multiplication, aggregating in random algorithms without intersecting using faces and points of the geometry as the variable.

Sak Yant or Yantra tattooing is a traditional form of Thai bodily art using Indian yantra designs. As a substitute for taking protective amulets into battle, warriors from a distant era would get sacred imagery consisting of complex geometrical, animal, and deity designs accompanied by Pali phrases inked onto their bodies. It is said to provide protection, power, fortune, charisma, and other benefits for the bearer.

By transforming the two-dimensional art into a three-dimensional form, the suggestion of sacrosanctity becomes tangible, revealing the interrelation between faith, creation, and its significance to understanding the complexity between man and nature.




The topic of photography's presumed truth claim is arguably one of the most heavily discussed subjects in relation to the media. It is safe to say that what ever indexicality it has had, is vanishing rapidly with advancements in technology. With the release of Adobe Photoshop in 1990 and the rise of social media in the early 2000s, and the sub sequential launch of hybrids like Instagram and Snapchat in the early 10s, today, nearly every person who owns a smartphone has the means to modify images and videos with just a few clicks. With this abundance of software and of course a little help from the Kardashians and other influencers, plastic surgery is now popular like never before.

In an effort to counterfeit this trend it has had a significant role in starting, Adobe has doubled down and in collaboration with researchers from UC Berkley developed a new method that detects modifications made to an image using Photoshop's Face Aware Liquify tool. It has been conceived by training a Convolutional Neural Network (CNN), which is essentially a form of deep learning and is significantly more accurate in detecting the alterations made to faces than the human eye. Although this new software has not yet been released for commercial use, Adobe has made the claim that "the journey of democratizing image forensics is just beginning".

Simultaneously, with Artificial Intelligence on the rise, Deepfakes, that allow the user to replace a person's face on any image or video with someone else's are being made available to a wider public. With legislators still struggling to implement rules for the digital sphere, the democratization of this technology poses significant challenges, as its use, can besides being somewhat morally dubious bear somewhat more serious consequences. If used with malicious intent or to spread false information, besides undermining a person's agency over their own likeness, it has the potential to pose a substantial threat to society. On a smaller scale, we need to confront ourselves with the unavoidable ethical question induced by the vast possibilities of image modification. Some countries have already taken


some first steps toward creating more awareness and transparency by passing laws that now require digitally manipulated images to be marked as such. As an image maker working across several disciplines I believe this to be an important step towards a more sustainable image that is being portrayed across an industry, that to some degree has made it its purpose to sell an image that cannot be reproduced.

Still, I often wonder how far this constant strife towards self-improvement and alleged perfection is going to go as there are no boundaries to what is possible in the digital realm. Plastic Surgeons report that more and more young people seek them out with images of themselves modified with face filters and the desire to achieve the desired objective to look just like that digital version of themselves. Often enough, they have to disappoint them, as the degree of alteration achieved by the filters is simply impossible to be implemented physically. Arguably, this creates an eerie form of cognitive dissonance that feeds into the growing digital anxiety we have as a society.


If we are physically limited to the body we are born into, the only means to satisfy our manic pursuit to become someone else or, at least a more desirable version of ourselves, is solely by digital means.

This series is aimed at reflecting and negotiating these boundaries, physically as well as digitally. The process of image manipulation through a range of different means is displayed along with its flaws and glitches, ending up in a kind of uncanny valley.


